WHERE: Camp Bob Marshall, located in the heart of the beautiful Black Hills on the northwest shore of Bismarck Lake, is six miles east of Custer, South Dakota.

WHO MAY ATTEND: Indian youth age 10 - 14 years.

COST: Campership fee is \$300.00 per camper.

TRAVEL: Parents, tribal groups or organizations that are sponsoring young people to attend camp are responsible for arranging travel to and from camp.

SURROUNDINGS: Camp Bob Marshall offers beautiful surroundings, trout fishing, canoeing and swimming on Bismarck Lake, cabins with wood stoves, a spacious craft and classroom building, an auditorium with stage, piano and fireplace, and bath houses with hot showers.

ACTIVITIES: Arts & crafts, cultural activities, campfires, skits, hiking, volleyball, mushball, basketball, swimming, canoeing, field trips and mini workshops on Indian culture, leadership, healthy living, creative writing, storytelling, puppetry, hoop dancing, etc.

SUPERVISION AND SAFETY: Activities are supervised by qualified staff members. There will be a nurse at camp at all times.
