WHERE: Whispering Pines Camp is located in the Bradshaw Mountains 9 miles from historic Prescott, Arizona. The camp is surrounded by the Prescott National Forest.

WHO MAY ATTEND: Indian youth age 10 - 14 years.

COST: Campership fee is **\$350.00 per camper.**

TRAVEL: Parents, tribal groups or organizations that are sponsoring young people to attend camp are responsible for arranging travel to and from camp.

SURROUNDINGS: The camp is surrounded by majestic Ponderosa Pine trees. Large boulders on the camp grounds enhance its beauty and havelina and mule-tail deer as well as beautiful grey squirrels have been seen close to camp. Campers sleep in cabins with access to hot showers, bathrooms, a dining hall and kitchen, and open air shelters.

ACTIVITIES: Arts & crafts, cultural activities, campfires, skits, hiking, volleyball, mushball, basketball, swimming, canoeing, paddleboats, and workshops on Indian culture, traditional games, team building, leadership, healthy living, creative writing, storytelling, nutrition, hoop dancing, etc.

SUPERVISION AND SAFETY: Activities are supervised by qualified staff members. There will be a nurse at camp at all times.
